# Comments on use of the E-Portfolio as a means of establishing knowledge and skill competencies

  Also, the definitions for artifacts, documentation, explanation, etc. were very unclear and confusing.
- I learned a lot through this process
- There were a few technical glitches but they were cleared up quickly.
- The E-portfolio was helpful in reflecting on knowledge and skills.
- Knowing more about the NICE process before taking the modules probably would have made this less disjointed and lengthy in completion.
- I struggled with showing skill, more face-to-face observations would have helped in my specific situation

#### Comments on use of the Venture platform (technical aspects)

- Assistance was prompt when I needed help.
- I wish I had been given contact info for Venture tech support to use outside the system itself.
- I never had a single problem with the website
- My portfolio kept saying that certain things were not complete despite the fact of that I had finished everything.
- I did not like the way a group of photos loaded in. Did not load in a sequence. I had to reshuffle them one by one manually.
- I had difficulty uploading some videos. For example, the system would tell me the video was uploaded but when my mentor would try to watch the video it wasn't there.
- My only confusion was regarding the signed consents, confidentiality, and how the identity of the children remained confidential to reviewers. I did call someone and received clarification that reviewers do not see the actual signed consents associated with the children presented. This might be helpful to mention in an FAQ.

# The three most important factors that helped you complete the e-portfolio process (rank 1 to 3 in importance, cont'd).

- 1) Having many pictures and documents to choose from for artifacts 2) Working with my mentor to learn how to talk about my work 3) quick responses from tech when Venture was acting up
- 1) Having a mentor. I was able to meet with my mentor on a regular basis, to check on my progress and answer any questions I had. 2) Making myself a timeline. Once I figured out how to make an artifact, I had more of an idea of how much time I would need. This helped me plan my time better and get things finished. 3) Being with my student on a daily basis helped me to focus in on specific competencies.

## The three greatest challenges in creating the eportfolio (please rank in importance)

- 1) Understanding how they wanted the artifacts put together 2) Not being able to meet with my mentor in person 3) Technological issues.
- 1) Technical difficulties 2) Time restrictions with being busy and putting it together 3) Getting permission from parents of former clients or clients I haven't seen in a while
- 1) Sometimes I had trouble uploading my artifacts, so I'd have to wait until IT fixed it. They were really great, though! 2) Evaluating myself 3) Coming up with artifacts.
- 1) How to think of the artifact. Was told to think of it as a noun by my mentor (best advice) 2) The format was set up odd. I would rather type in a horizontal space than a vertical column.
- 1) Making sure that I was portraying in the video of my student what was asked in the competency.
- 2) Sometimes if my student wasn't in the mood it was hard to get footage of me working with him so many times things that I had planned I had to put off for another day.

## The three greatest challenges in creating the eportfolio (please rank in importance, cont'd)

- 1) Organizing work completed with designated artifacts 2) Unable to create video artifacts
- 3) Classroom with unusually high staff turnover hard to provide consistency at times.
- 1) Not knowing requirements of NICE while completing modules made for disjointed preparation of artifacts 2) Not having peers who had been through the process to talk to. 3) My own visual limitations in capturing photo/video for artifacts.

# How the Venture e-portfolio process can be improved for future candidates

- This process was great on the Venture site, no changes need to be made.
- It would be very nice if some of the OHOA module assignments would automatically meet the requirements for some of the knowledge competencies.
- Having an email or document containing Venture info such as the website address to login, and various contact people and their info. A FAQs page may be helpful.
- Please fix the technical difficulties with checking off if a competency is complete.
- More assignments linked to eportfolio
- Having complete access to modules to refer back to
- Less requirements
- It would have been nice for me to see a portfolio. I could have learned so much more if I had been able to experience another portfolio.

# How the Venture e-portfolio process can be improved for future candidates

- I didn't see any need for improvements
- To provide a workshop session midway, just to see if any consistent skills/knowledge were lacking or unclear. The trainings on how to participate using the e-portfolio were incredibly helpful.
- Continue updating the system and have more tutorials.
- I believe steps are being taken by offering mentoring webinars and creating documents that tie OHOA assignments to competencies. The NICE process should be introduced at the beginning of OHOA so that participants can be thinking of evidence as modules are completed rather than waiting until someone has completed the bulk of the modules. The Intervener Pilot Project was very helpful.

### Benefits of creating the e-portfolio

- It was good self-reflection
- To learn about yourself
- Allowed me to see what I do on paper and to prove with facts and documentation that I know this specialty
- Showcasing my knowledge to others
- Being able to recognize what you do know and what else you need to know.
- The biggest benefit to me personally has been learning how to talk about my work and explain it to others; I also enjoyed the self reflection process once I got the hang of it. I hope it will also become beneficial as a way to help interveners gain more recognition as professionals in the near future.

### Benefits of creating the e-portfolio

- Having to reflect on the things you do as an intervener and why you do them is very enlightening. It helps you see your successes as well as where you need to improve. It also gave me a great sense of accomplishment. The e-portfolio process can seem very overwhelming at first, but as you move through it, you become more aware of all the little things that make this relationship between student and intervener so important. It is also very rewarding to be able to refer to yourself as a deafblind intervener.
- The benefits I experienced are: finding out my strengths and weaknesses, areas that I need to improve, it gave me new insights and perspectives into DeafBlindness and how it affects individuals, it refreshed information in areas I haven't thought about in a while and I got to demonstrate my knowledge and passion for my work with individuals who are DeafBlind and receive feedback
- Wonderful way to see your body of work as a whole. You can really see trends of your areas of strengths and areas to improve
